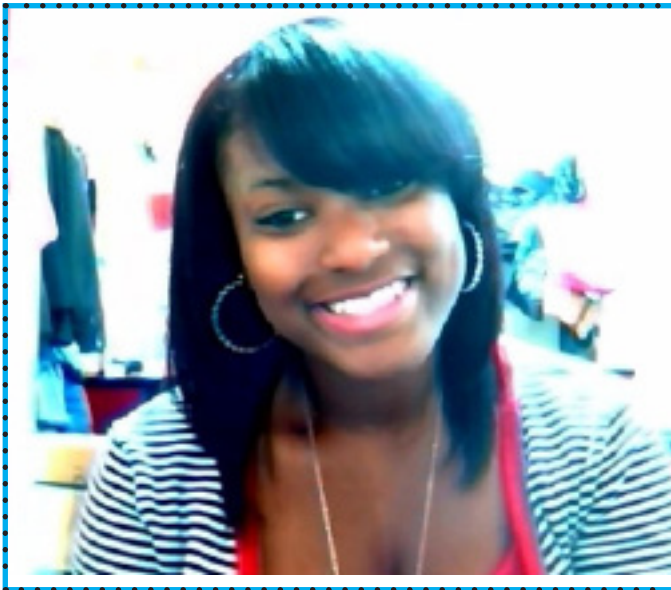


Editor-in-Chief Shout Out!
